## Foreword

In the **4 Elements Exhibition**, Siew Lee explores our link to the four elements of the natural world. A world which spawned us, but which we are doing terrible things to — like stripping fish from the ocean till we have deserts of seawater with no fish, like polluting our rivers and streams till nothing can breathe in them, like poisoning our air with fumes till it rains acid, and stripping our life-rich forests to bare earth.

Malaysia now has the world's highest rate of deforestation. In two years we lost 14.4 percent of our forest cover, that is 47,278 sq km (18,244 sq miles), or 66 times the size of Singapore.

There is an urgent need for us to return to the way we were, when we were people who understood and lived in harmony with ourselves, with our natural energies, and our natural environment. We need to rediscover our true selves. As individual persons, as a society, and as a civilisation of humankind all over the world. There are 7 billion of us now, living in 196 countries, speaking 6,500 languages, each with its own value-system and worldview. Despite this diversity, we are the same human inside, and share the same world outside.

We hope this exhibition could, in some way, contribute towards our return to our true selves and our harmonious relationship with our planet. Our only home in the endless, endless dark of the universe.

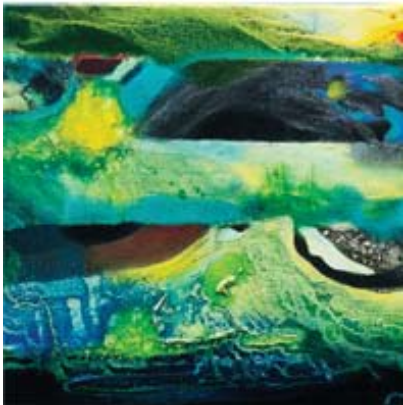

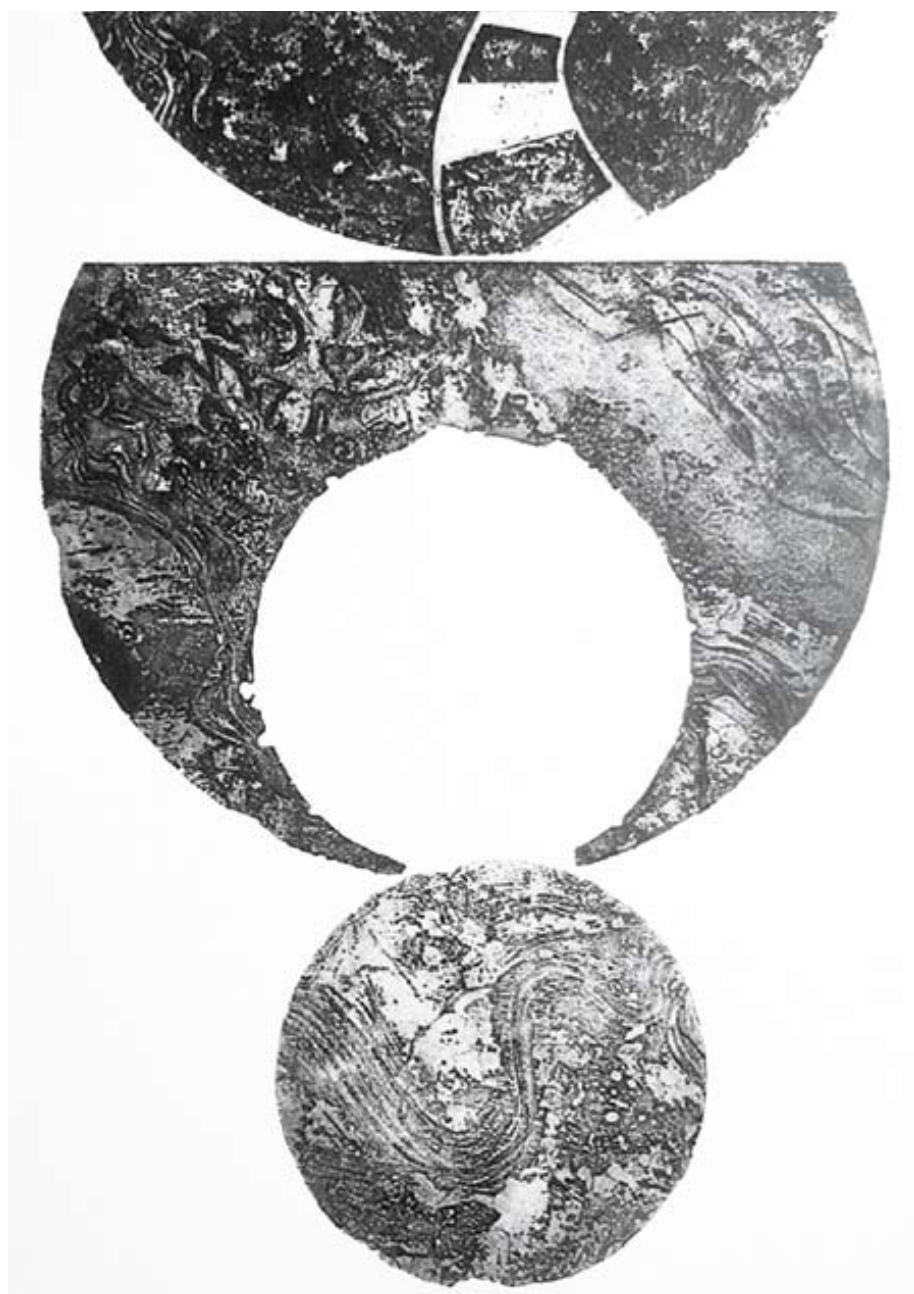

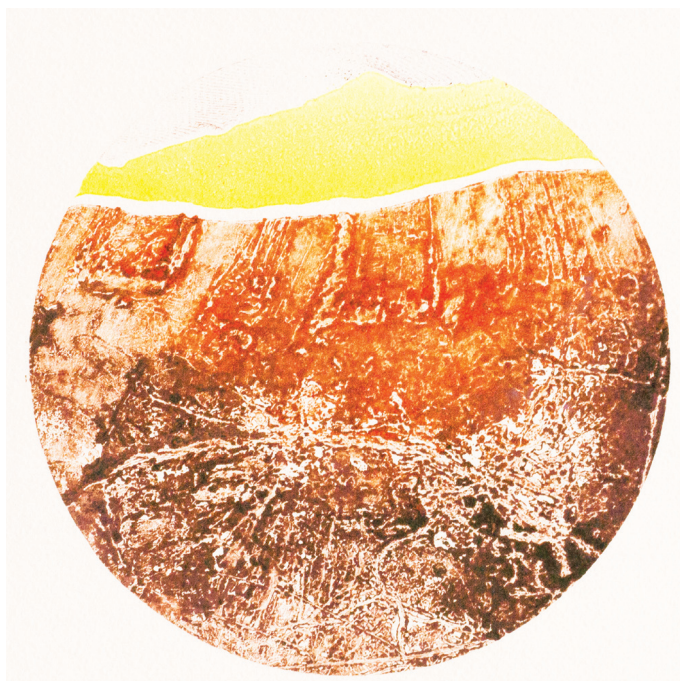


**Guardian of Cosmos.** Acrylic & charcoal on canvas. 150cm x 150cm. 2014

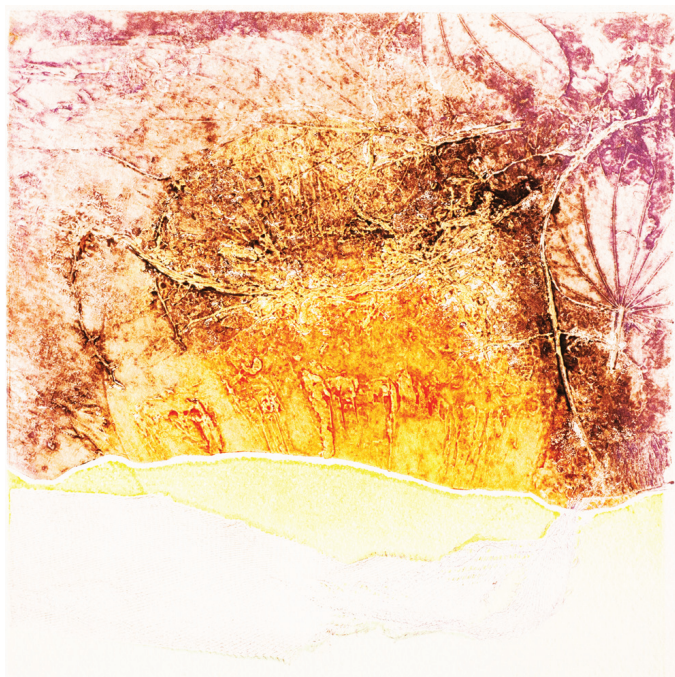

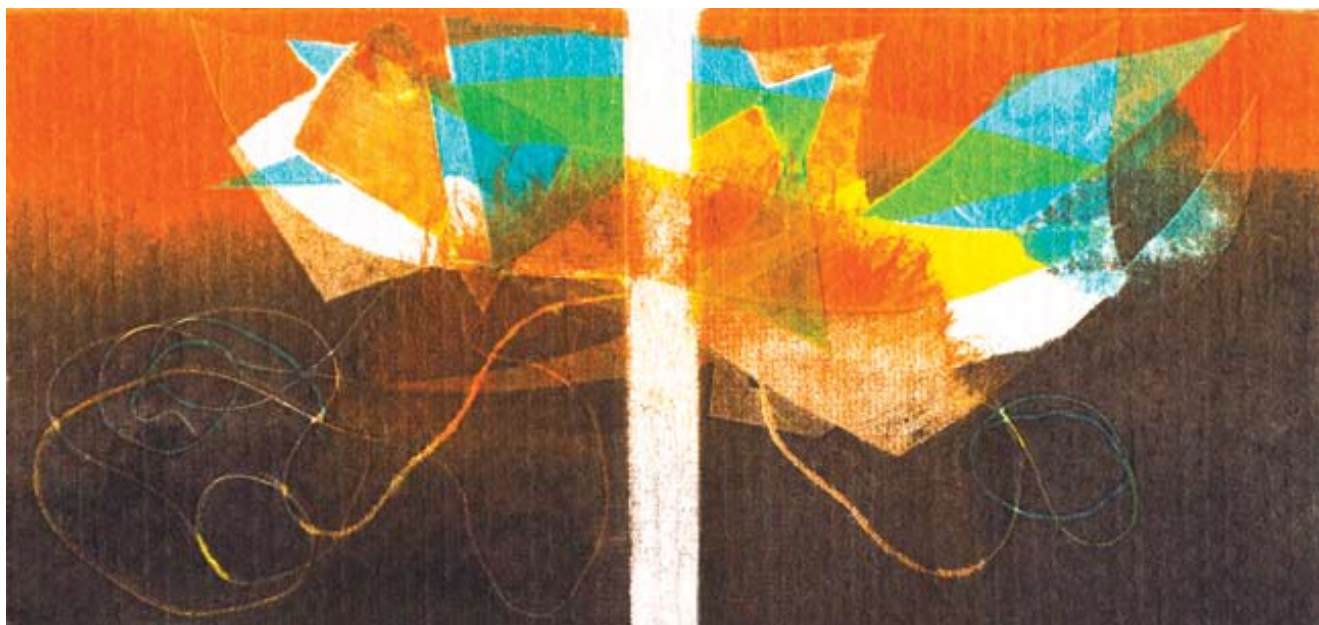

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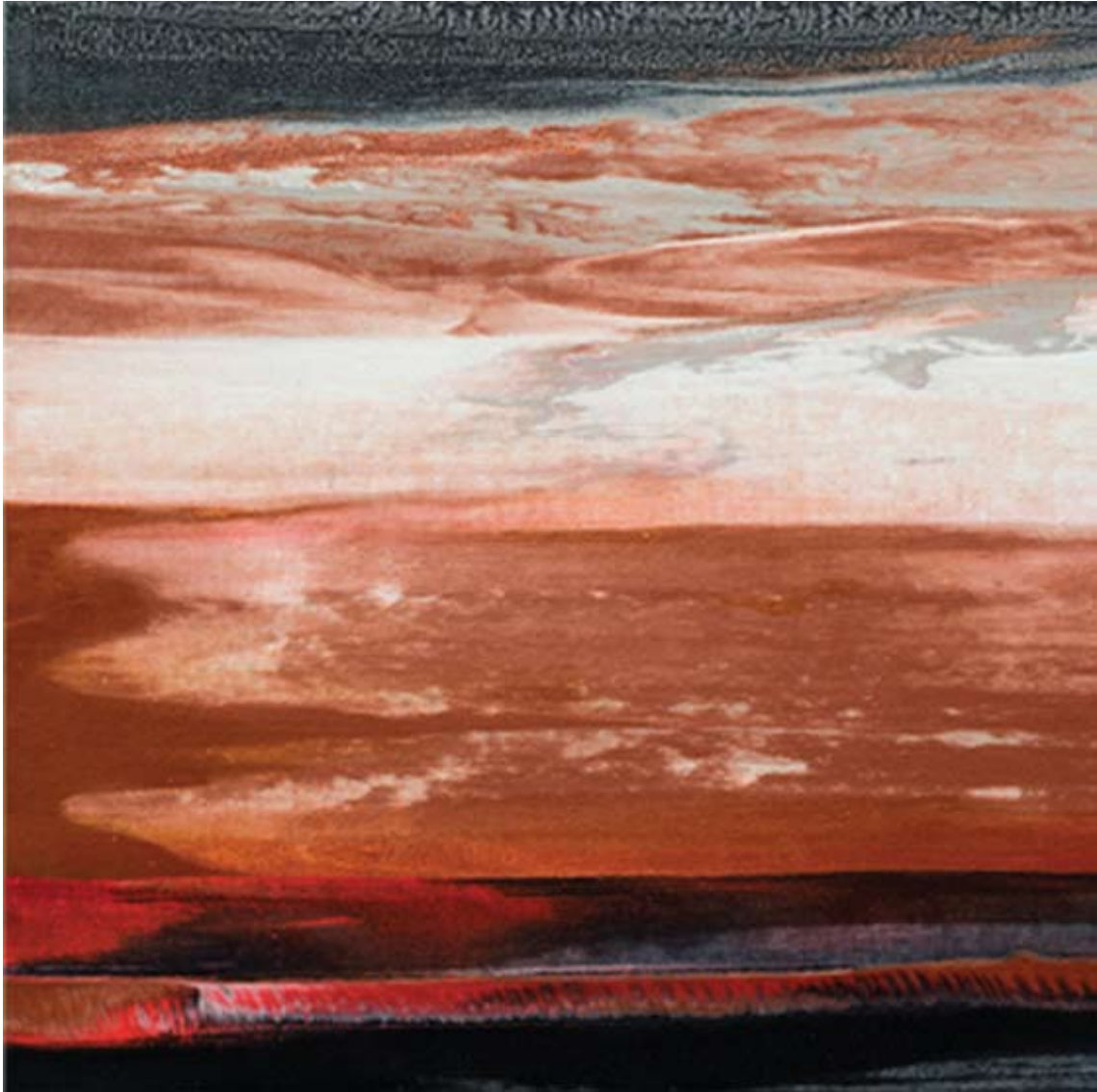
